**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

The Island lake Christian Retreat Center offers rustic, shared accommodations. Guests are required to bring their own bedding. There are 16 family bedrooms and seven dorm-style room. Family bedrooms include one double bed and one bunk bed in each and it is expected that a minimum of two people will use these rooms. The dorm-style rooms are outfitted with multiple bunkbeds and sleep six to eleven people in each. Rooms or bunk beds can be reserved on a 'first come, first served' basis. The fee for accommodation for both nights per person is \$70. Once onsite, attendees will select their bunk based on the room type selected during registration.
