



## Entomological Society of Alberta Application for Student Travel Grant



The ESA offers its Student Members grants to help cover the cost of travelling to an ESA Annual Meeting. Grants are valued at a maximum of \$300 each depending on the number of successful applicants, and up to five Grants are awarded each year. To be eligible to receive a Grant, the student must present a paper or poster at the meeting and be travelling from more than 50 km from the meeting location; each successful applicant will receive no more than one Grant per year.

To apply:

- complete this application form
- attach an abstract for your presentation or poster (not to exceed 250 words),
- send all documents by e-mail to the Secretary of the ESA.
- obtain an endorsement from your supervisor by cc'ing your application to her/him

Normally, names and institution affiliations of Travel Grant recipients are announced at the Annual Meeting banquet and posted on the ESA website.
