



## Entomological Society of Alberta Undergraduate Award in Entomology



The ESA invites undergraduate students to apply for the Undergraduate Award in Entomology that is sponsored by the ESA. The Award is valued at \$500 and may be presented annually by the ESA to a deserving undergraduate student in recognition of academic achievements related to entomology. Normally, the name and institution affiliation of the Undergraduate Award recipient is announced at the Annual Meeting banquet and posted on the ESA website.

To be eligible to hold an Award, students must attend a university or other post-secondary institution in Alberta, or have graduated no more than six months prior to the deadline for applications.

To apply for the Award, please submit the following:

- a letter of interest to the Awards Committee of the ESA, that includes the following: name, postal address, telephone and fax number, e-mail address, educational institution attended, degree pursued and number of years completed;
- a letter of support written by your major professor;
- documents which demonstrate academic achievement that may include transcripts, copies of papers written about entomology (e.g., independent study or review paper), picture or list of identified insects in your collection, etc.

Applicants shall ensure that all documents are received by the Chair of the ESA Awards Committee, or are contained in envelopes postmarked, no later than October 1, 2009. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
